Mass communication is changing the world. Today, like no other time in history, people are witness to tragedies from around the globe on their computers or in the media. LOTUS is a small, results-oriented organization that not only saves lives but does so with the minimum amount of expense. LOTUS provides immediate financial support to at-risk children in Viet Nam whose lives are threatened by heart disease. There are hospitals and well-trained doctors in Viet Nam that perform life-saving open- and closed-heart surgeries, but it is not free to these poor and desperate children.

LOTUS is a resourceful and time proven option for donors like you, those who like to know where their contributions are being spent and want immediate results for their giving.

LOTUS is managed by an all-volunteer Board of Directors, each of whom has experience in Viet Nam. We are men, women, combat veterans and Vietnamese nationals.

In 2010, working in three different provinces in central Viet Nam, LOTUS

conducted seventy-eight family assessments, paid for one hundred and eleven heart examinations, and helped provide funding for sixty-two successful children's heart surgeries.

Here's the good part: LOTUS, with your support, contributed \$26,425 towards those sixty-two successful surgeries with an additional \$92,222 contributed towards those same surgeries by five other international and domestic "partner organizations" that we cooperate with.

Dear Friends,

Last year was a year in transition, during which we terminated our sewing and embroidery programs and expanded our heart surgery program into 2 additional provinces and almost doubled the number of heart surgery beneficiaries. We were able to assist 62 Vietnamese children in having life saving surgery.

This year we recently received approval from the government to provide our heart services in an additional province (Quang Binh) and already have a list of children waiting for surgery and your help.

Thanks to all of you donors we can and are making a valuable contribution to humanity.

Kindergarten Program

LOTUS has continued its cooperation with two veteran's organizations that funded kindergartens in Quang Tri several years ago. Members of both organizations periodically return to Viet Nam to supply and refurbish the kindergartens they originally helped fund.

In 2002, the LZ Russell Association, a group of Marine veterans, returned to Viet Nam and built a kindergarten in the Village of Hau Vien, Cam Lo District. To maintain their on-going relationship with the Hau Vien Kindergarten they return frequently to upgrade the building and re-supply the children with school supplies.

The NorthLand Vietnam Veteran's Association (NVVA) has a membership that flourishes in Northeastern Minnesota and Northwestern Wisconsin. In 2003, the NVVA provided funding to build a kindergarten in Hai Thai Commune, Gio Linh District. Representatives from the organization visited Hai Thai in 2010 to bring school supplies. They saw that the school needed some repairs and will provide funding again this year to address some of those needs.

The continuing relationship with these veterans is one of the high points of John's work in Quang Tri.
